

As we get ready to begin regular Student Ministry Small Groups and Midweek activities, we want to make you aware of the preventative measures we are taking in light of the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic.

Prevention Measures:

An easy way to remember our procedures is by the 5 S's:

1. **Screening:** Upon entry, every student and adult will be screened with COVID questions and a temperature checked. (see questions below)
 - If a temperature is above 100.4 we will ask you not to participate that day.
 - If the answer is "yes" to any of the questions we ask you not to participate that day.
2. **Safety Masks:** Masks will be available for anyone who needs one.
3. **Sanitizer Stations:** Sanitizer stations will be adequately placed throughout our space.
4. **Spacing:** We will maintain the spacing of chairs in the Worship Center (Midweek), adequately space chairs in the Kids Worship Room (Small Groups), and ask everyone to social distance (Worship Center and small group rooms).
5. **Sanitize:** We will sanitize the spaces that we use after our time together every week.

COVID Questions:

1. Within the last 14 days, have you been in close contact (within 6ft, for 10+ minutes, without a mask) with someone who has a confirmed case of COVID? (family member, classmate, teammate, boyfriend/girlfriend, etc.)
2. Within the last 14 days, have you developed any COVID symptoms? (shortness of breath, vomiting, diarrhea, loss of taste or smell?)

We ask you to be familiar with these questions and plan ahead of time. If you feel ill or if you have had close contact with someone who has COVID, please stay home. The CDC recommends quarantining for 10-14 days, while watching for symptoms and following guidelines.

ASSUMPTION OF RISK AND WAIVER OF LIABILITY RELATING TO COVID-19

The novel coronavirus, COVID-19, has been declared a worldwide pandemic. It is extremely contagious and is believed to spread mainly from person to person contact. First Baptist Church (FBC) has put in place prevention measures to reduce the spread of COVID-19, however, FBC cannot guarantee that you or your children will not become infected with COVID-19.
