FULL TRAINING PROVIDED FOR EACH AREA OF SERVICE.

Volunteers serve on Sunday mornings on a rotating schedule unless otherwise noted.

GREETER

PARKING LOT GREETER

Offer directions and assistance in the parking lot.

DOOR GREETER

Offer a friendly welcome to people as they arrive.

SHUTTLE DRIVER

Drive people to and from the church building.

WELCOME DESK

Offer information to answer questions or provide directions.

USHERS

Welcome and assist people in finding seats in the Worship Center.

GUEST ENGAGEMENT

Meet with guests in Guest Connection to answer questions and connect with the church. You will also help those looking for resources in their walk with Christ. Volunteers serve after the services.

DECISION PARTNER

As individuals respond during the invitation, be prepared to pray with and share the Gospel with those wanting to take next steps.

MEDICAL TEAM

This team of health care professionals serves by providing basic medical care in the event of an accident or emergency on Sundays, Wednesdays and/or special events. Medical certification and background check are required.

SAFETY TEAM

This team provides a safe environment for members and guests to gather on Sundays, Wednesdays, and/or special events. Law enforcement, military, and/or security background preferred but not required. A background check is required.

PRAYER TEAM

Be willing to pray during our services for God's touch on us and be devoted to persistent and effective prayer.

BAPTISM

Make sure that all necessary baptismal equipment and facilities are available and ready prior to each baptismal service. Perform necessary cleanup after the baptism.

COMMONS CAFÉ

Volunteers usually serve one Sunday per month. Volunteers will be responsible for replenishing coffee, water, and some cleanup.

MUSIC MINISTRY

CHOIR

Sing in both services and lead people to praise God every Sunday morning. Rehearsals are Sunday mornings before service and Wednesday evenings.

BAND AND PRAISE TEAM

Play an instrument in both Sunday services as needed. Rehearsals are before service on Sundays and Wednesday evenings.

MEDIA TEAM

PROPRESENTER OPERATOR

Run ProPresenter media and lyric slides for worship, sermons, and announcements during Sunday services.

CAMERA OPERATOR

Operate cameras for online services and Commons, overflow, and Nursing Mothers room TV's during Sunday services.

LIVE AUDIO TECHNICIAN

Mix the live audio elements of the service in the Worship Center.

BROADCAST AUDIO TECHNICIAN

Mix the audio elements of the service for online broadcast in the broadcast room.

SWITCHING OPERATOR

Direct the switching between cameras and graphics for the online broadcast in the broadcast room.

STUDENT WORSHIP

MIDWEEK ADULT LEADER

Be present on a weekly basis to assist with ministry on Wednesdays.

MIDWEEK WORSHIP TEAM

Play an instrument or sing in the Midweek Worship Service on Wednesdays.

MIDWEEK MEDIA TEAM

Includes operating ProPresenter, lights, camera, and sound equipment for Midweek Worship on Wednesdays.

MIDWEEK PHOTOGRAPHY AND VIDEOGRAPHY

Take pictures and video footage during Midweek Worship on Wednesdays, and as needed for special events.

MIDWEEK SAFETY TEAM

Provide a safe environment for students and guests to gather during Midweek Worship Service on Wednesdays and special events as needed.

KIDS AND PRESCHOOL WORSHIP

PRESCHOOL WORSHIP LEADER

Care for children (birth to pre-K) during the 11:00 A.M. service. Reinforce the foundational Biblical truths being taught in Small Groups. Encourage the children as they learn in Preschool Worship, as well as foster a loving and safe environment.

KIDS WORSHIP I FADER

Welcome each child into the Kids Worship Center and participate in a worship experience that teaches God's truths while having fun and being full of energy. Help lead and interact with children in song, games, Bible study, and prayer once a month. Make sure each guest is welcomed and introduced to a Kids Welcome Buddy so no child ever feels alone and scared.

KIDS MIDWEEK WORSHIP LEADER

A musical learning and training experience to engage and equip children (preschool to 5th graders) for meaningful worship through singing on Wednesdays.

LOVE PEOPLE

FULL TRAINING PROVIDED FOR EACH AREA OF SERVICE.

DISCOVER FIRST

Work with the church staff by setting tables and chairs, decorations, assisting with food service, and cleanup. Discover First takes place approximately 5 times a year.

ADULTS

SMALL GROUP LEADER

Our Adult Small Group Leaders play a very significant role in the overall spiritual health and well-being of our church. The purpose of our Small Group ministry is to reach, teach, and minister to people.

MEMBER CARE

Contact and lovingly pursue members who have not been attending church. The goal is to do all we can to encourage members to faithfully attend, be involved, and continue walking with the Lord.

SENIOR ADULT CARE

Regularly contact select Senior Adult members who are unable to attend to ensure they are physically, emotionally, and spiritually well.

MEN'S MINISTRY

Connect and cultivate intergenerational relationships among the men of First Baptist. This on-ramp is designed to assist you in growing in your faith and being a part of community.

WOMEN'S MINISTRY

Connect and cultivate intergenerational relationships among the women of First Baptist. This on-ramp is designed to assist you in growing in your faith and being a part of community.

LOVE PEOPLE

STUDENTS

STUDENT SMALL GROUP LEADER

Lead a Student Small Group by reaching students, teaching them the Word of God, and ministering to them regularly. Student Small Group Leaders are also highly encouraged to be at Student Ministry events to cultivate relationships and further invest in their group of students.

STUDENT SIDEKICK

Adults in our church who want to partner with a Student Small Group by committing to pray for them consistently, keep in touch with them regularly, and visit their Small Group occasionally to build relationships, share testimonies, and encourage them in their faith.

PRESCHOOL AND KIDS

WELCOME TEAM

Greet and make families feel welcome and secure as they check in. Take guests to the appropriate room.

PRESCHOOL SMALL GROUP LEADER OR SUBSTITUTE

Shepherd preschoolers in Small Groups on a weekly basis. Help create a loving and secure environment and help them learn foundational Biblical truths.

KIDS SMALL GROUP LEADER OR SUBSTITUTE

Lead elementary kids (kindergarten - 5th grade) in the Small Group setting. Encourage them to develop a deeper level of growth into God's Word. Help children discover their unique God-given gifts and abilities to add value to the body of Christ and to impact the world with the Gospel.

SHEPHERDING HEARTS TEAM

This team serves kids and students with special needs, providing specific and intentional environments so they can learn and grow.

OFFICE VOLUNTEER

Duties may include answering the phone, making phone calls, or assisting with large mailings during the week as needed.

GO

FULL TRAINING PROVIDED FOR EACH AREA OF SERVICE.

FIRST CONTACT MINISTRY

Make home visits to Sunday guests to show Christ's love, provide information, and answer questions about Christ or the church. Contact them within two days of their first visit.

PRESCHOOL AND KIDS

MIDWEEK MISSION PRESCHOOL AND KIDS

Help kids learn how to share their faith and become equipped to live on mission for Christ. They will learn about local and global missionaries while having opportunities to participate in outreach projects.

SPECIAL EVENTS

Help serve in various ways at events such as Fall Festival, Vacation Bible School/Backyard Kids Club, and other community-oriented events.

STUDENTS

STUDENT HOST HOME

Host groups during The WKND, special fellowship events, Bible Studies, etc. at your home throughout the year as needed.

ENGLISH AS A SECOND LANGUAGE (ESL)

Share the love and truth of Jesus with internationals and immigrants while helping them learn English: teaching, teacher support, hospitality, fellowship, prayer group, administration, security, etc.

GO

AFTER SCHOOL GOOD NEWS CLUB

Lead games, provide snacks, teach Bible lessons, and build relationships with elementary students through our local schools.

W.R.A.P. TEAM

There are many ways to help as a W.R.A.P. team member by supporting in tangible, emotional, and spiritual ways - "wrapping" around foster and adoptive families. You can also help facilitate resources for families that want to adopt or foster. W.R.A.P. stands for:

Wrestling in prayer
Respite/Babysitting
Acts of service such as mowing the lawn or providing a meal
Positive and encouraging words

FACILITIES MINISTRY

Work with the staff to maintain the building and grounds.

HANDY PERSON MINISTRY

Offer assisstance to members who are physically unable or lack the resources to meet their needs. This team can offer basic transportation services and run errands, as well as minor home maintenance.
